

## 2019 SIGN UP SHALER AREA BOYS SOCCER BOOSTERS VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES/JOB DESCRIPTIONS

#### CONCESSION STAND COORDINATOR/BUYER – Beth Michalek

• Obtain list of needed items from Coordinator and purchase items from Sam's Club. Take items to concession stand and load in storage/freezer. Provide copy of receipt to Treasurer for reimbursement.

#### **CONCESSION STAND OPENER** – Erica Ritts

Arrive 45 minutes prior to the first game starting. Opens concession stand for all home games and makes
sure all supplies from storage closet are in concession stand. Put candy, chips, etc. out for display and start
cheese warmer. Prepare hot pretzels. Once concession stand is set up and JV game concession stand
workers are present, opener may leave the stand. This job should take approximately 20-30 minutes.

#### **CONCESSION STAND GRILLER** – <u>Tony DeLeonibus</u>

• Responsible for Grilling at home games, items include hot dogs and hamburgers

#### **CONCESSION STAND CLOSER** – <u>Jeannie Maurer</u>

• At half time of the Varsity game, closer will go to the concession stand and make sure closing duties are handled. Shut off cheese warmer and make sure Varsity game workers start restocking and cleaning the concession stand after the half time rush is over. At the end of the game, go over to the concession stand and make sure all items are being put away, all items are being restocked and all bins are placed back into the storage closet. Concession stand should be clean and all items returned to closet before leaving.

## **CONCESSION STAND SCHEDULER** – Cindy Clark

Responsible for making sure there are volunteers to work all home games. Send out email notification to all
JV and Varsity parents/guardians regarding dates and number of volunteers needed. If no one volunteers
for a game, scheduler is responsible to send out additional emails to recruit volunteers.

### SPONSORSHIP COORDINATOR - Craig/Beth Michalek

• Responsible for organizing and collecting sponsorship information from players/families. Arrange for any banners to be created for season.

#### HOME GAME PROGRAMS – Craig/Beth Michalek

• Development of game program as well as obtaining visiting teams player information to insert in to master program.

## HIGH SCHOOL PARENT REPRESENTATIVE - Rick Schwartz/Tom Woessner

• Arranging Team snack after away games according to booster guidelines.

#### MIDDLE SCHOOL PARENT REPRESENTATIVE -
