### **Shaler Area Boys Soccer Boosters provides to players**

The Boys Soccer Boosters Organization exists to provide the boys with a positive soccer experience. Booster membership is not mandatory for your son to play for the HS or MS team.

The money raised from the Booster Member Fees, the Concession Stand, Homecoming Stand, Sponsorships, and fundraising opportunities covers:

- Two short sleeve practice shirts (HS)
- Short sleeve shirt with logo designed by a senior (MS and HS)
- Team bonding event (HS)
- Game night programs (HS)
- HS Team & Senior Banners displayed at the field
- Meals/snacks after away games (MS and HS)
- Senior Night (HS)
- The cost of the banquet for each player (who is a booster member) (MS and HS)
- Banquet gift for each player (MS and HS), banquet programs, dinner for coaches
- Awards given out at the banquet (MS and HS)
- \$500 Scholarship (given to one graduating senior at the banquet)
- Additional training and/or equipment not provided by the SASD

## **Booster Fees**

The booster member fee for the 2024 season is \$100.

For HS players, you can also give a check (not cash) in an envelope to Alex Martin-Adler. Please make sure the players name is in the memo section or on the envelope.

For MS players, you can also give cash or a check (made out to SASB) to Kim Rios.

## **Parent/Guardian Responsibilities**

1. As a parent/guardian of a JV or Varsity soccer player (HS), you must work in the concession stand for **2** two-hour blocks and donate a food item for each block worked.

The concession stand is open during all JV and Varsity home games. Four 4 parents work during the JV game and 4 parents work during the Varsity game. It is recommended, JV parents should work during Varsity games and Varsity parents should work during JV games so parents/guardians can watch their player's game.

Bring your food item to the concession stand BEFORE the start of the JV game (by 6pm).

You are required to work **2** two-hour blocks for each JV/Varsity player (i.e. if you have 2 sons, you will need to work 4 blocks total).

A SignUpGenius will be emailed to you soon.

\*Middle School parents are not required to sign up for a concession stand duty but your help is always appreciated.

2. Help with events throughout the year
  - a. Volunteer to help with fundraising, the concession stand, senior night, or the banquet
  - b. Donate food/drink/supplies and work the homecoming booth
  - c. Sell items to help us fundraise throughout the year

## **Middle School Players**

Each player needs to sign up to be a ball boy at 2 home HS games. Four boys will be needed at each JV game and 4 at each Varsity game. Games are on Tuesdays and Thursdays (JV- 6pm, V - 7:30pm). Players need to show up 15 mins before the game. A Sign Up Genius will be sent out prior to the start of the season.
